Workshops are opportunities for hands-on experiences that help interpret and apply the faith concepts that are presented at the theme presentations and worship. This year’s theme is based on Galatians 3: 28-29

1. **Many Faiths One God-** We live in a very diverse world, with many different faiths. How do we share our faith and learn from others who have different beliefs that our own? Come to learn and discover how our similarities outweigh our differences!
2. **Peace Lab Netta:** Does the world have you stressed out? Feeling weighed down by a burden? Come to the Spirituality Center and find meditation techniques to help you with these challenges.
3. **Connecting Through Christ:** Fingerprints are unique; just like you! Everybody has them. Come discover how the unique you is connected to the hero and saints that have come before you!
