- 3. I agree to listen to the group leaders. Their instructions are important for our group and for our safety.
- 4. I agree to be on time always and not hold the group up. I will travel with a watch or some accurate way to keep track of time. I will help others be on time as well.
- 5. I agree to follow the rules of the organization we are traveling with. I will know them and respect them before we leave.
- 6. I agree to participate in all that I am supposed to participate in. To be in the places I am assigned and to be positive and supportive in those places.
- 7. I agree to use technology appropriately. I will turn my cell phone/MP3 player off when appropriate and asked of me. I will ask to take pictures of people I don't know.
