An appropriate service is required for inurnment in the Columbarium to be conducted by the clergy of the church (or designee).


### How Do I Purchase a Niche?

Please call the Church at 770.393.1424 to request an application. The fee for a niche is \$1,600. This includes the plaques inscribed with the name and dates of birth and death, an urn designed to fit the niche (one urn per niche), and perpetual care. The fee does not cover the cost of cremation. Niche assignments are allocated in accordance with the desires of each applicant on a first-come, first-served basis.



### Memorial Plaques

A Memorial Wall is also located in the Memorial Garden. You may purchase a bronze plaque for \$400 in memory of loved ones whose remains have been scattered or interred elsewhere. The fee includes the cost of engraving.
