

Saint Luke's Participant Expectations & Guidelines

- **Each participant must submit a SLPC Covid-19 Waiver prior to event.**
- **Each participant/household must pre-register for event.**
- **Non-symptomatic:** If you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, we ask that you stay home.
- **Managed vulnerability:** If you are vulnerable to COVID-19, as identified by the CDC (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/need-extra-precautions/index.html>), we ask that you experience this event safely either at home or in your car, if appropriate. If applicable, the event will be live streamed for viewing at home.
- **Contact tracing:** In the event you or anyone in your household tests positive for COVID-19 up to 14 days after the event at Saint Luke's you will inform Shannon Dill or another Saint Luke's staff member, who will inform Shannon. Confidentiality will be respected, but we will provide communication to attendees regarding the possibility and presence of someone with COVID-19 may have been at our event.
- **Health Screening Checklist:** Each participant/household will be asked to complete a Health Screening Checklist prior to entering any event.
- **Each participant will provide their own:**
 - Mask
 - Chair or other item upon which to sit.
 - Water bottle
 - Hand sanitizer
- **Maintain social distancing:** Each individual must remain at least 6ft from other individuals not in their immediate family at all times. Please stay 6 feet away from people not in your immediate family. This includes not touching, hugging, or handshaking. Please stay in your designated parking spot/seating area as well. There will be no movement between and among people, or meandering.
- **Masks:** masks must be worn correctly (covering nose and mouth) at all time by all attendees 3 years of age and older (unless briefly removed for drinking).
- **No access to church building:** Though we will gather on the Saint Luke's campus, the building will remain closed to us. This means no access to water fountains or bathrooms. In the case of bathroom emergencies, no more 1 person (or a parent and child) may be permitted building access at a time.
- **Inclement weather or a rise in Covid cases in our area may result in cancellation:** Publicity of event cancelation will be done through Saint Luke's social media and website platforms.
- **Church staff and volunteers will enforce these guidelines:** Anyone choosing to be non-compliant will be asked to leave.
